Dear Councilmember Allen:

This letter is provided to you pursuant to section 103(b) of the Comprehensive Policing and Justice Reform Second Temporary Amendment Act of 2020, effective December 3, 2020 (D.C. Law 23-151), regarding a serious use of force by Imar Samaraay of the Metropolitan Police Department on June 15, 2021, in the 2300 block of Raynolds Place, SE, involving a tactical takedown of an individual armed with an illegal firearm. Following the arrest, the individual complained of pain to their left hand and arm; he was transported to a local hospital for treatment of a bone fracture in his hand. The individual, a juvenile, was charged with Carrying a Pistol Without a License, Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, Possession of Unregistered Ammunition, Unlawful Possession of Ammunition, and Resisting Arrest.

The mother of the individual who was the subject of the serious use of force consented to the public release of the body-worn camera footage, which has been posted on the MPD website.
